You will see that the two photos, line up perfectly.

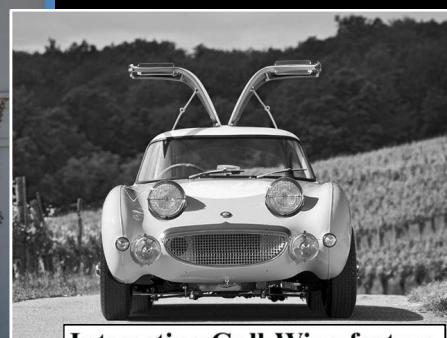
